Rachel: This morning?
Alex: Yes. I went to bed early last night and got up early this morning. I can study better in the morning.

Question: What did Rachel do yesterday?

- No. 4 OK, boys and girls. Please remember three things when you are here. One. You must always be quiet. Two. You cannot eat or drink here. Three. You must leave your bags here when you want to study at the desks over there. Many students are reading or studying. Don't forget this is a place for everyone. Thank you.
