では、1 から始めます。

Mom: Oh, that's hard. Would you like some juice?

- No. 2 Woman: Ken, you visited Australia last week, right?
Ken: Yes, I went there to see my aunt in Sydney.
Woman: That's nice! How many times have you been there?

次は 2 です。

2 は、英語の対話又は英語の文章を聞いて、それぞれの内容についての質問に答える問題です。質問の答えとして最も適当なものを、問題用紙の A から D のうちから一つずつ選んで、その符号を書きなさい。なお、英文と質問はそれぞれ 2 回放送します。

では、始めます。

Sam: I'm in front of the supermarket, so I will buy the eggs now.

Sam: OK! I want to buy some flowers for grandmother here.

Question: Where will Sam buy flowers before he sees his grandmother?

- No. 2 (電車の走行音)

I go to school by train. The train I take every morning always has so many people that I can't sit. I know who will get off at the next station. The man usually listens to music, but today he is doing something different. He is reading e-mails on his phone and he looks sleepy. The train will arrive at the next station soon, so I will be able to sit down.

Question: Who will leave the train at the next station?

No. 1 (ジングル)

Dad: It's one hour away.

Daughter: Can we go there today?

Dad: Of course. What time is it now?

Daughter: 8:30 a.m.

Dad: We can take a bus at 9, 10 or 11 o'clock.

Daughter: Well, I need two hours to make a special box lunch for us.

Question: What time will they take the bus?



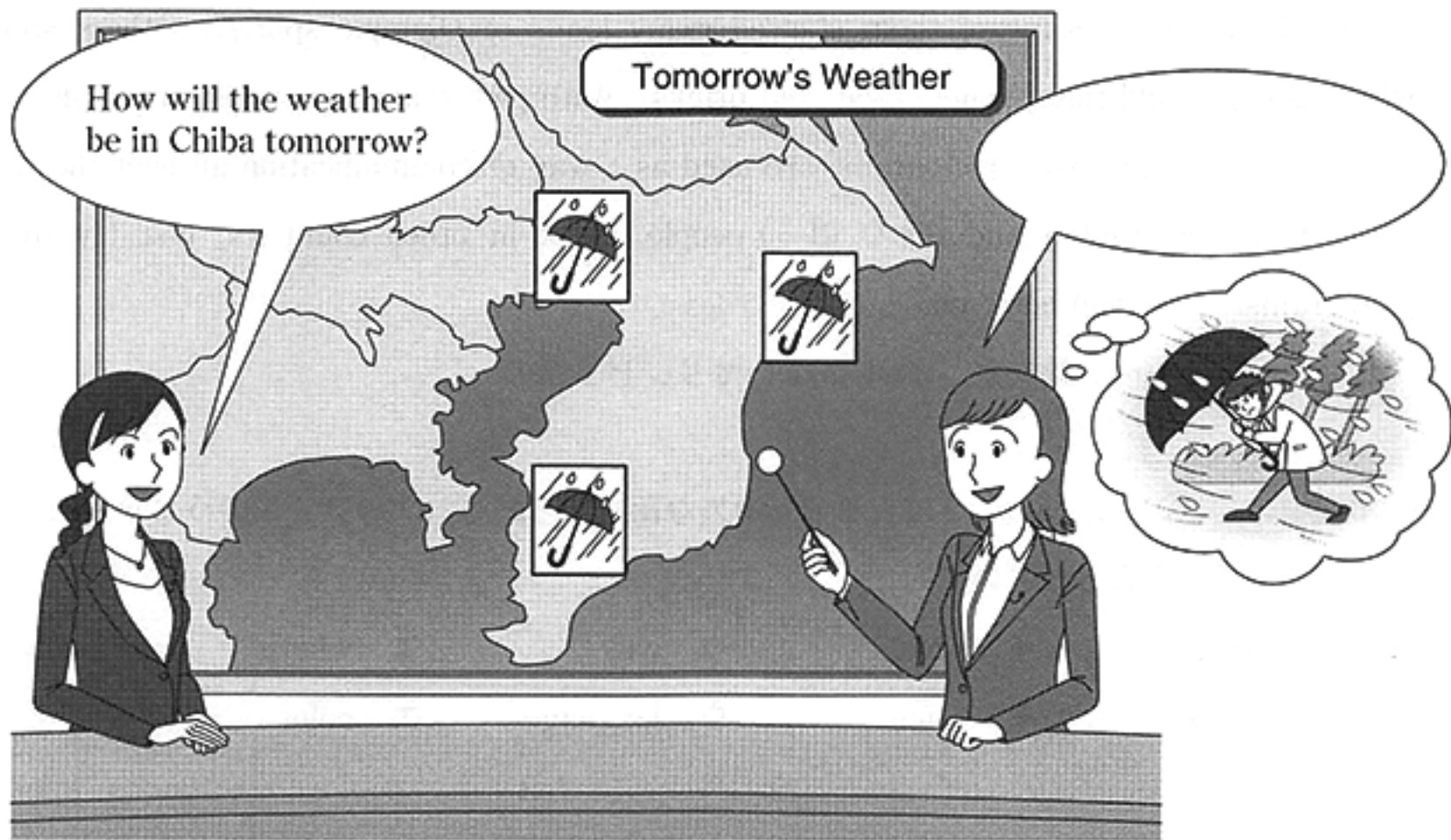

How to Play with EX-8

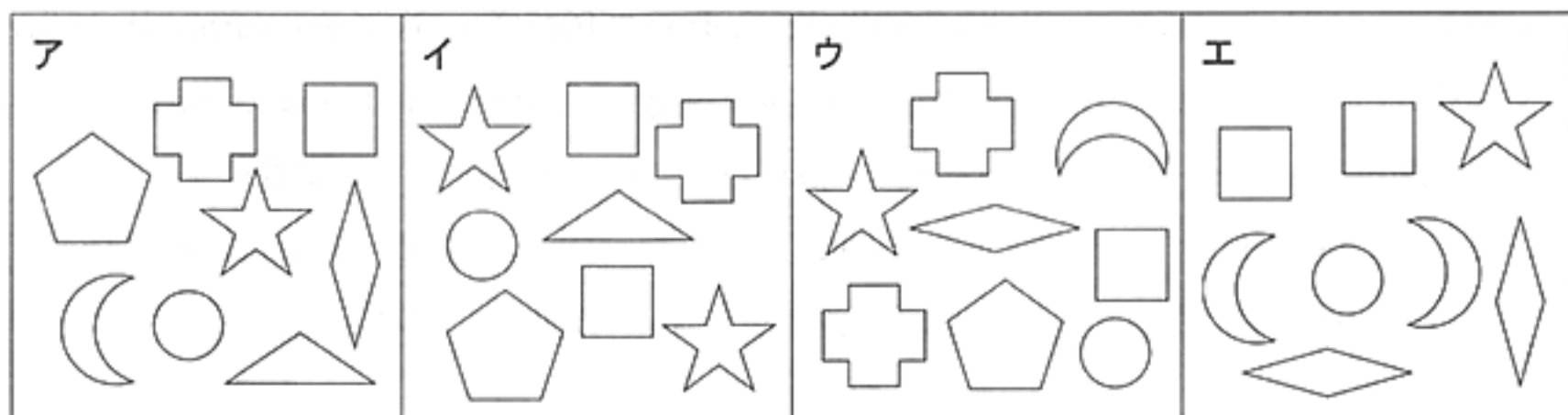
Welcome to the world of EX-8! We hope you spend a wonderful time building your own work.

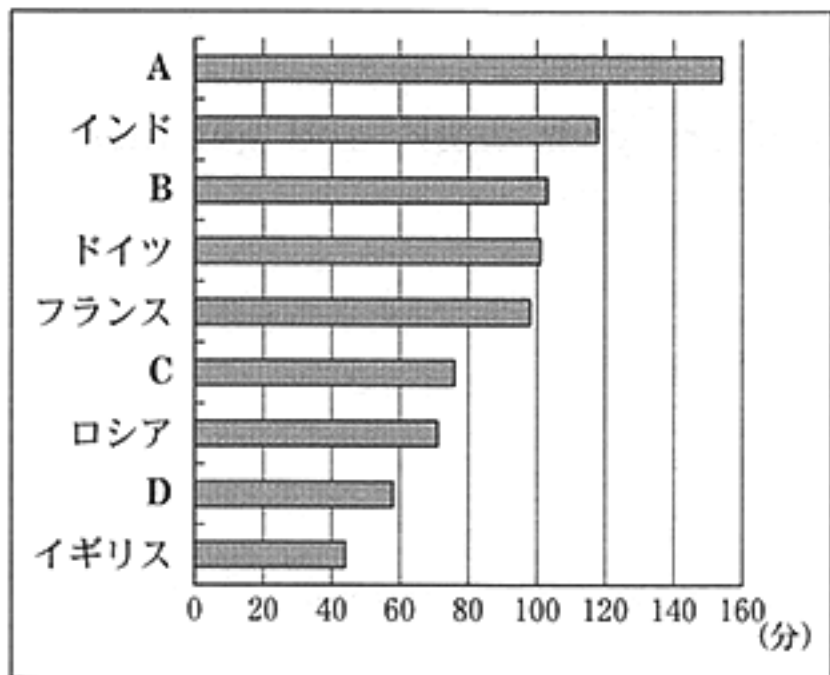
8 ある調査(survey)にもとづいた英文を読んで、あとの(1)~(4)の問いに答えなさい。

“86.61”—What is this number? This number shows how many years the average Japanese women can live. Japanese men live an average of 80.21 years. Today, our lives are very long, so it is important to think about how we spend our time living.

Some people say that we spend one third of our lives sleeping. That is true if we sleep for eight hours in one day. If we live for 80 years, we find that we spend about 27 years of our life sleeping. What else do we do in our lives? Here are the results of an interesting survey.

“22 hours and 3 minutes”—This is the average time for us to smile and laugh during our lives. When we feel happy, we smile and sometimes laugh. If we smile and laugh, something good will happen. Some doctors say that laughing keeps us in good health. “22 hours and 3 minutes”—Do you think that’s enough?

“150 days”—You will be surprised. We spend such a long time looking for things we have lost. For example, 59% of people answered that they often lose pens. 55% of people said they often lose money. They remember that they put some money on a table or in a bag, but they are shocked when they can’t find it.



The time used for searching is in each country. This graph shows how many minutes people from some countries spend looking for things in a month. People in Korea search for about 100 minutes, but Chinese people spend more than two hours searching. People in the U.S. don't search as long as Japanese people.

“6 years”—One survey says that in one day we spend 2 hours and 20 minutes using our cellphones. That means one person will use their cellphone for six years during their lives. Do you think it's too much? We need to think about ways of using time to make our lives better.
