

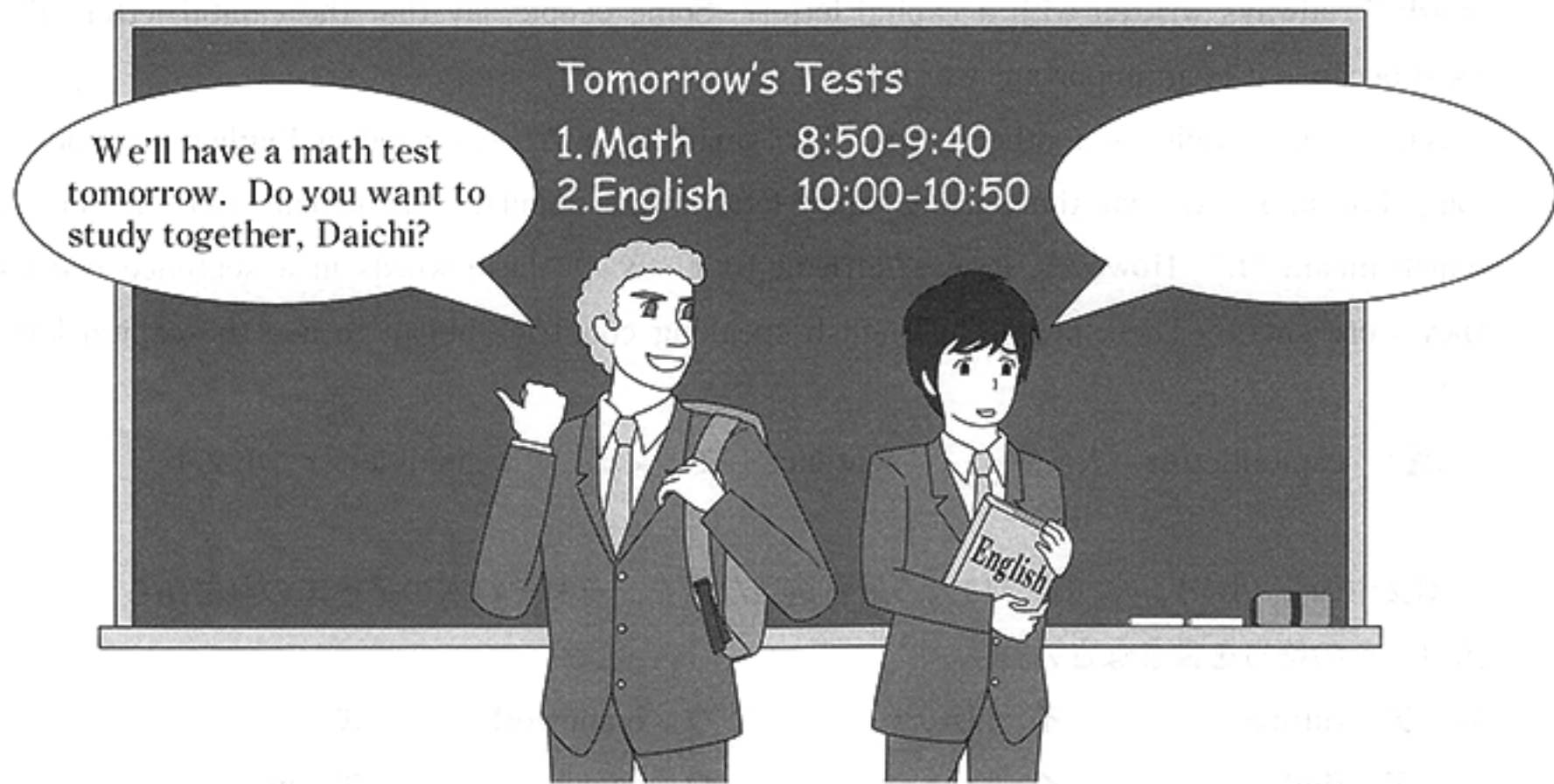

It rained this morning, so I took the bus today, not my bike. I met my classmates Rin and Mana on the bus. We talked about our music festival, and we promised to have lunch together. Everyone in my school brings a *bento*, and I like to see their *bento*. They usually have rice, fish or meat, and vegetables in a lunch box, but each one is different and looks delicious. It's very interesting for me because our lunch in Canada is not like this. *Bento* is one of my favorite parts of Japanese culture. I think it is delicious and also looks nice. Japanese people like to use many colors like white, yellow, red, green, and black in their *bento* to make them beautiful. My host mother makes me a beautiful *bento* every morning, and I enjoy it very much. She always says, "You should eat with your eyes first."

Eating *bento* with friends is always fun. Rin, Mana, and I ate lunch together, and I was interested in their *bento*. Rin's *bento* was more traditional than mine. Her older brother made *bento* for their family today. He goes to a cooking school and cooks dinner for them when he has time. Mana's *bento* was really cute. There was a popular *anime* character in her *bento*. She often makes a cute character *bento*. I took a picture of her *bento* to show my family and friends in Canada. I think she is a wonderful *bento* artist. I also liked the fruit Mana had: apple rabbits. She taught me how to make them.

6 steps to make apple rabbits:

1. Cut an apple in half and cut each half into three pieces.
2. Cut the core out and take the apple seeds out of each apple piece.
3. To make two ears, cut the apple skin in a V-shape, like this!
4. Put the knife under the apple skin at the top of the V-shape and cut carefully.
5. Stop cutting at the end of the V-shape, and then the apple skin will come off.
6. If you like, put apple seeds on the sides like the eyes of a rabbit.



This evening I followed these six steps but I didn't use the seeds for their eyes. I also cut the skin to make their ears short because they looked cuter. It was easier than I thought. I'm glad that I learned how to cut fruit into cute shapes.
